Location and arrival

- The event will be held at the Hämeenlinna University Centre, address Vankanklähde 9.
- If you arrive by car to the university centre, there is parking space along Visamäentie and behind building D.
- The route to the parking area is signposted.
- Disabled parking is via Vankanklähde, access is signposted.

Shared transport

- On Wednesday 5.6., non-stop buses will operate between Hämeenlinna railway station and university centre between 7.15 a.m. and 10.15 a.m. Hämeenlinna railway station will be greeted by event staff from 8.00 a.m. onwards.

- Shared transport during the days runs as charter services between the railway station, the university centre, hotel accommodation and the Vanajanlinna evening party.

- Please note that there is no shared transport available on Network day 4.6.

Registration

- Registration takes place in the lobby of building N, near the main entrances. Registration opens on 5.6. at 8 am and is open throughout the event.
- When registering, you will receive an event pass, which gives you access to e.g. meals and transportation.

Luggage storage

- Luggage storage is located on the first floor of building D.
- There are staff in the space to guide you.
- Storage of goods at your own risk.
